LOCATED at the old Railway Station and staffed by heritage enthusiasts, the Alexandra Timber Tramway and Museum was formed in 1985 and has built up an impressive collection of narrow gauge steam, diesel and petrol locomotives and assorted rolling stock.

A large range of historical artefacts from the early logging period is also on display.

The Alexandra Timber Tramway and Museum is open on the **second and fourth Sundays of each month** and most public holidays from 10.00am to 4.00pm

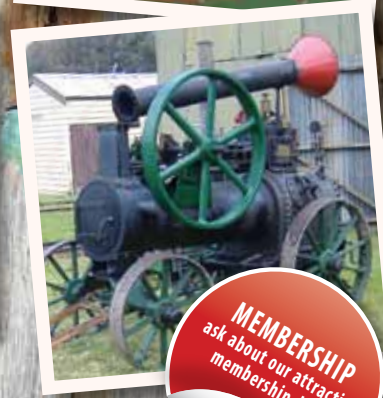
GROUPS ~ we will organise a package especially to suit your group's needs.
